MAYFIELD AND FIVE ASHES COMMUNITY SERVICES

Hardship Fund

- 1. MAYFACS administers a fund for the relief of hardship in Mayfield and Five Ashes. A small committee of trustees considers and determines applications for grants. Complete confidentiality is maintained during this process.**
- 2. Residents of, those who work in and parents or carers of those attending school in Mayfield or Five Ashes may apply for a grant from the Fund.**
- 3. 'Hardship' is regarded as difficulty in meeting the basic needs of an applicant or family member. 'Basic needs' include accommodation, heating, food, hygiene and (in the case of school age children) attending school, and other activities. Other issues that may be causing hardship will be considered. The fund has helped people with fuel bills, debts, school expenses, travel costs and other bills.**
- 4. Applicants should in their applications give full details of their hardship, how it has arisen, on what the requested grant will be spent and why they are not able to meet this expenditure from their income. They should also confirm the steps they have taken to maximise their benefit income and give details of any other grant applications they have made.**
