Community Car Drivers Needed! - Expenses are reimbursed for your costs of travel.

Our Community Car Service runs every day of the week for those who need to access medical appointments but cannot get there any other way. In the last 4 months, requests have increased by 60% which could mean an additional 200+ drives this year! More appointments are being scheduled for Saturdays to get people the medical care they need in hospitals that are getting through waiting lists. This means we really do need more help to support this vital service for our community.

Do you work Monday to Friday, and would love to volunteer for MAYFACS, but only available on Saturday's? Do you have any spare time to undertake a drive every now and then? Do you know if your Employers offer matched volunteering time as part of their Corporate Social Responsibility programme?

Community Car Volunteers can choose what how often they are available to drive for us and the more drivers we have, the more this shares the support needed. You can also choose whether you prefer to support local drives within our Parish or travel further afield. It really can be flexible around what you can offer. **Expenses are reimbursed for your costs of travel.**

MAYFACS SUPPORT SERVICES

MAYFACS has many services to help you should you need any additional support at any time. All requests will be treated in the strictest of confidence, and our team will do everything we can to ensure you have access to any help that you need - be it financial, personal, social or medical.

Everyday Support Services

With our incredible team of volunteers, we can support you should you need help with emergency shopping, collecting prescriptions, getting to our activities, navigating other support services and agencies, as well as borrowing a wheelchair, DVD or Jigsaw! If you need us for anything, please just get in touch, and if we can't help, we can tell you who can! We are here for everyone within our community.

Community Car Service

Our Community Car Service ensures you can get to medical appointments when you may have no other way to get there and is open to anyone who needs to use it. Our growing team of volunteers can drive you to these appointments and get you safely home again. Whether it is a local appointment, or further afield, please contact us. This is a paid for service - literally covering the cost of providing the service and fuel for our drivers, however, if cost is a concern, please always let us know and we can look at ways we can support this for you.

Community Fridges

Community Fridges are available at Heathfield, Hailsham and Uckfield and are open to anyone, no questions asked, to collect food as and when you need it. They are there to prevent food waste and support our environment by ensuring food goes to a home. They receive donations from supermarkets, cafes, local produce suppliers, and other generous donors, as well as the general public.

Food Bank Referrals

We are able to make referrals for families and individuals to local foodbanks for anyone in need of this support, be it short term or longer. Parcels are created for you, and specific requests/dietary requirements can also be accommodated. Collections or deliveries to your house are both available. Anyone who wishes to donate food to the local foodbanks can do so at their local supermarkets and help support others in need.

MAYFACS Hardship Fund

You may be finding it difficult to make ends meet following the recent pandemic and cost of living crisis, or through a change in living or family situation.
